yoga day



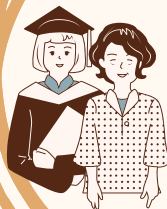

KRUU Award Ceremony 2023



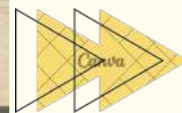
