"Trees are vital, Without them life would be fatal."



This day aims at spreading awareness about the goodness of the fruit which is found to be one of the most popular fruits especially in India.






"Love the Earth as you would love yourself"








Padhenge Toh Badhenge

Five-Day Training on School Health & Wellness Program for Master Trainers



The Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health and Family Welfare under the aegis of Ayushman Bharat recently launched the School Health Program. Under this program, 100 school Principals/Academic Heads and Resource Persons from different CBSE COEs (Centre of Excellence) such as Patna, Punjab, Delhi, UP, Haryana, Jharkhand, Assam, Kerala and Maharashtra were chosen as Master Trainers to get five day long extensive training at NCERT, New Delhi from 22-26 August 2022.

Ms Bhavna Arora, Senior Academic Coordinator from Darshan Academy Delhi was selected by CBSE COE Delhi (West) among top 12 from 120 Resource Persons working with COE Delhi (West) to undergo the training. The program trained Master Trainers on the following (11) eleven themes broadly:

- 1) Growing up Healthy
- 2) Emotional Well-being and Mental Health
- 3) Interpersonal Relationships
- 4) Values and Responsible Citizenship
- 5) Gender Equality
- 6) Nutrition, Health, and Sanitation
- 7) Prevention and Management of Substance Misuse
- 8) Promotion of Healthy Lifestyle
- 9) Reproductive Health and HIV Prevention
- 10) Safety and Security against Violence and Injuries
- 11) Promotion of Safe Use of Internet, Gadgets and Media.

It further envisages two teachers in each school as the School Health and Wellness Ambassadors with the help of these Master Trainers, who will conduct age appropriate and culturally sensitive prevention and promotion activities in schools to improve the health and well-being of school going children in grades VI-IX and XI.



ANNUAL PROJECT WEEK






KISAN DIWAS






