Furthermore, they talked about the art of making gulkand, a sweet preserve made from rose petals. The combination of these activities added a delightful floral touch to our day.










Red Colour Day



BOOK REVIEW SESSION FOR TEACHERS


The integration of Spiritual Education with academic excellence was designed for Darshan Academy Delhi teachers, wherein all staff members participated with zeal and enthusiasm.
