

Orientation Program for parents of Grade X and XII



Darshan Academy, Delhi, organized an Orientation Program for parents of Grade X and XII students to provide insights into the academic curriculum, board examination structure, and holistic development approach. Head of School Ms. Mamta Sabharwal emphasized the importance of parental support, while Academic Coordinator Ms. Monika Sachdeva outlined the CBSE curriculum, assessment criteria, and study strategies. Senior Coordinator Ms. Bhavna Arora highlighted the need for balance between academics and co-curricular activities, and Middle Wing Coordinator Ms. Anupriya Narang discussed ways parents can help students manage stress and distractions.

A special session by Child Psychologist Dr. Kiranpreet focused on adolescent behavior, stress management, and emotional well-being, guiding parents on supporting their children through exam pressure. The program concluded with motivational words from Ms. Mamta Sabharwal, reinforcing the school's commitment to academic excellence and character-building. The interactive session strengthened the parent-school partnership, equipping parents with strategies to support their child's success.





Tools for Effectiveness

Mr. Sven's session on Tools for Effectiveness focused on maximizing productivity by emphasizing quality and impact rather than simply increasing work hours. He encouraged participants to shift their approach from working longer to working smarter, ensuring that efforts are directed toward meaningful outcomes. A key discussion point was identifying the most important aspects of life, helping attendees align their priorities with their actions. He also introduced the idea that focus is the new IQ in today's fast-paced world, emphasizing that the ability to concentrate on high-value tasks is a crucial skill.

To enhance focus and efficiency, Mr. Sven discussed practical tools such as Maker Time and Manager Time, helping individuals balance deep work with administrative tasks. He also introduced the "Touch It Once" principle to reduce procrastination by addressing tasks immediately. Additionally, he explained the Eisenhower Matrix, a framework for distinguishing between urgent and important tasks, ensuring time is spent effectively. By applying these strategies, individuals can work more efficiently, minimize distractions, and prioritize tasks that truly matter.

Mother's Day


Students of Class VI A, along with their class teacher, organized a heartfelt morning assembly to honour the irreplaceable role of mothers in our lives.








Noun Hunt



We congratulate our faculty members on this achievement and appreciate their dedication to academic excellence.








KRUU- ASCEND 2025


