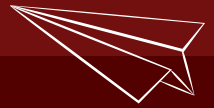


Picnic Nur-KG 2025

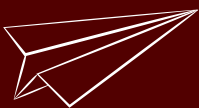
Free Multi-Speciality Health Camp

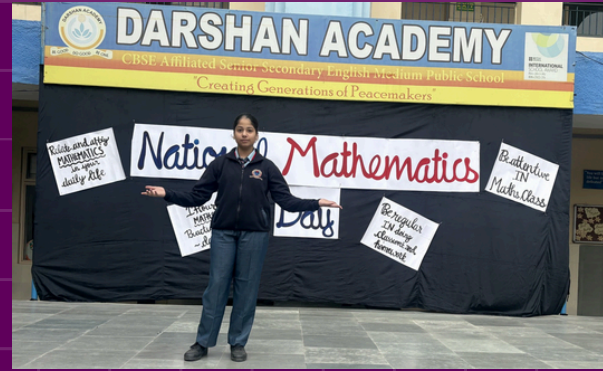

Christmas Craft in Online Classes

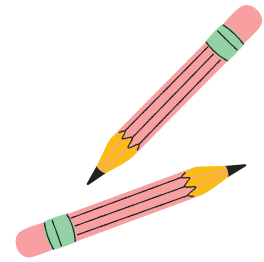

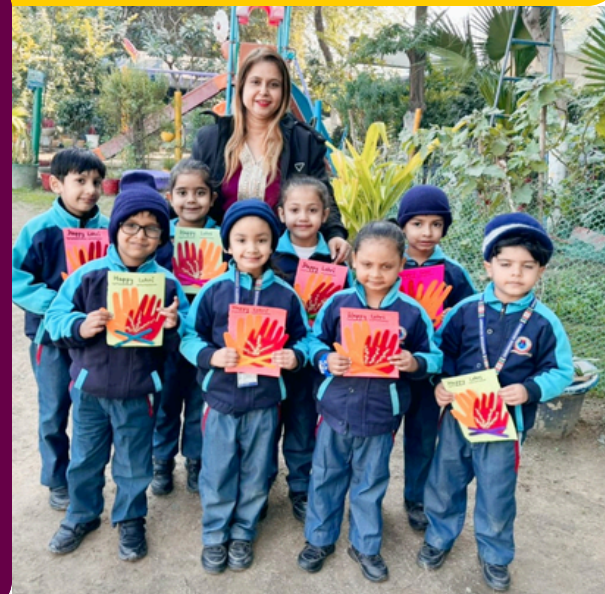
Thanks Giving Day and 8th Mass Meditation Session 2025

EDU-CONNECT PROGRAM

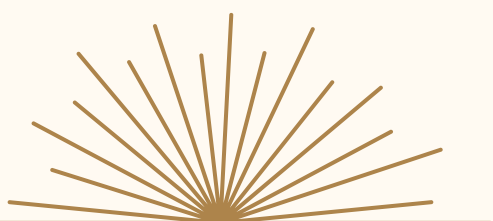

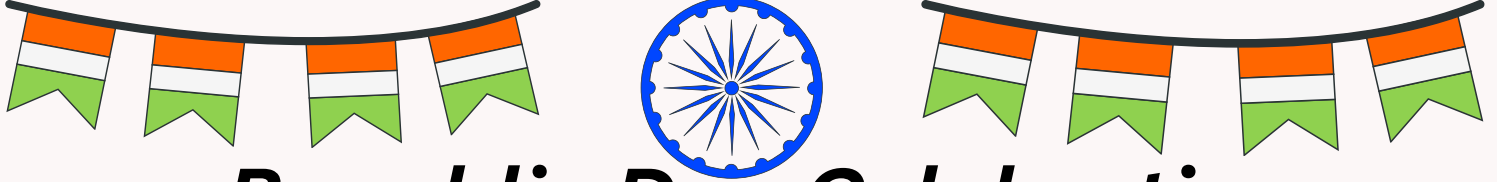


Zumba Session

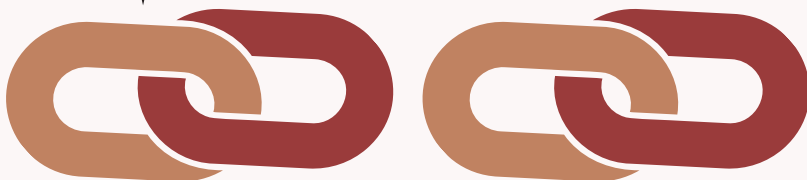
Republic Day Celebration

GK Club

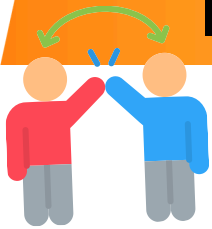


Missionaries of Charity

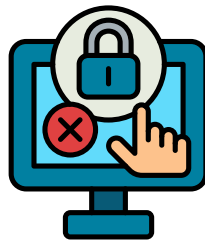


Computer Club

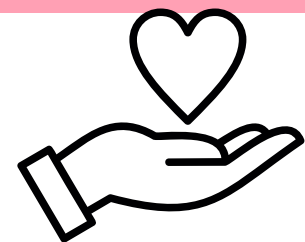


Eco And Discovery Club

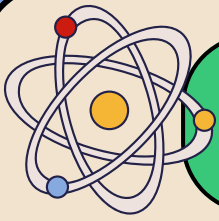


ENGLISH SUPERSTARS

National Science Day



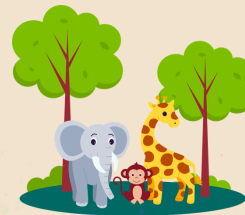

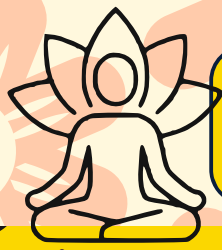


Holi Celebration

Under the guidance of HOS Ms. Mamta Sabharwal, the initiative motivates students to maintain high standards and a spirit of healthy competition.



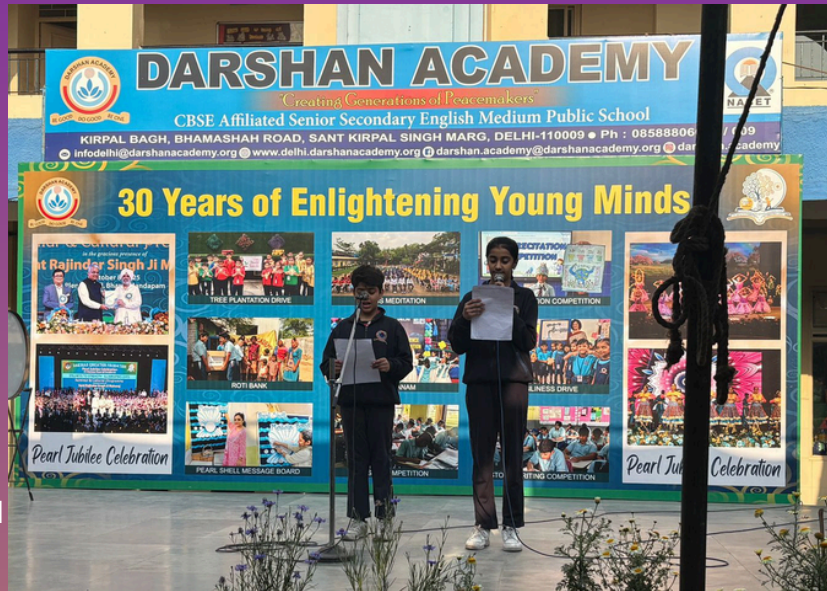
